Man Faces 80 years in Prison after Pleading Guilty to Stabbing Death of 14-Year-Old Girl

Ezequiel Padilla-Villalobos today pleaded guilty to murder and kidnapping charges in the stabbing death of a 14-year-old girl last December in Commerce City.

Padilla-Villalobos pleaded guilty to second-degree murder (F2) and second-degree kidnapping (F3) of a child with a knife as part of a plea agreement in which he will be sentenced to 80 years in prison.

He had been charged with first-degree murder, first-degree felony murder and five counts of sexual assault.

Sentencing is set for Nov. 12 at 9 a.m. in Division E of Adams County District Court.
