Bennett PTSA Treasurer Charged with Forgery and Theft of More Than \$15,000

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young today announced that Angelita Sue Ramos (DOB 02/24/75) has been charged with theft and forgery for embezzling more than \$15,000 from the Bennett Elementary School Parent Teacher Student Association.

Ramos, of Bennett, is charged with seven counts of theft and seven counts of forgery for taking cash and checks totaling \$15,119.21 from the PTSA at Bennett Elementary School between 2012 and 2013 while she served as treasurer of the organization. The charges allege that she forged signatures on checks and stole cash from fundraising events held at the school, including book fairs.

Ramos was arrested Tuesday. Her bond is set at \$5,000.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
