Nursing Home Employee Convicted of Sexually Assaulting Two Female Patients

Antonio Nieto (DOB 07/01/72) was convicted today of sexually assaulting two female patients at a Broomfield nursing home.

The Broomfield County District Court jury convicted Nieto on all five charges after a week-long trial. Nieto was convicted of two counts of first-degree sexual assault on an at-risk adult (F2), two counts of sexual assault on an at-risk adult (F3) and one count of unlawful sexual contact on an at-risk adult (F4) involving two female patients at Broomfield Skilled Nursing, 12975 Sheridan Blvd., where he was employed as a certified nursing assistant.

He was convicted of sexually assaulted a 59-year-old patient between July 10 and July 19, 2013, and sexually assaulting a 73-year-old patient on August 14, 2013. The jury heard a recorded phone conversation from the jail in which Nieto admitted to his fiancé that he had “made a mistake” and said he deserved to be punished.

Both victims testified during the trial.

“We’re very fortunate that the jury came back with the right decision in this case,” said District Attorney Dave Young, who prosecuted the case with Deputy District Attorney Amy Petri-Beard. “We’re very thankful that the victims can have some peace of mind that justice was served.”

Nieto’s \$100,000 bond was revoked and he was taken into custody.

He will be sentenced at 8:30 a.m. Jan. 15 in Division A of Broomfield County District Court.
