**Woman Charged with Vehicular Homicide and DUI in Fatal Commerce City Crash**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young today announced that charges of vehicular homicide and DUI have been filed against Robbin Leigh Verser (DOB 1/18/58) in a fatal traffic accident in Commerce City on Nov. 21.

Ashley Nicole Bradberry, 24, was killed in the head-on crash at 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Vasquez Boulevard in Commerce City.

Verser, of Denver, is charged with one count of vehicular homicide while driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs (F3) and one count of vehicular homicide as a result of reckless driving (F4).

Verser will be advised of the charges at 1:30 p.m. today in Division 6 of Adams County Court. Bond is set at \$20,000.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
