**Board Member Charged with Theft of Funds from Thornton Veterans Memorial Foundation**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young today announced that Tami Colleen William (DOB 03/26/58) has been charged with theft for embezzling more than \$14,000 from the Thornton Veterans Memorial Foundation.

William, of Northglenn, is charged with one count of theft (F4) for transferring foundation funds to her own use between November 8, 2010 and December 24, 2013. She served as treasurer of the foundation which was created to build and maintain a memorial for veterans in Thornton.

William was served with a summons and complaint today and is due in court for advisement of the charge at 8:30 a.m. on December 12 in Division 2 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
