Colorado Army National Guard Recruiter Charged with Theft

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced today that Colorado Army National Guard recruiter Christopher Thomas Clark, DOB 02/05/88, has been charged with theft.

Clark, of Aurora, is charged with one count of theft (F3) for fraudulently receiving \$28,000 in referral bonuses for recruits.

Clark is due in court Feb. 18 at 8:30 a.m. for advisement. He is free on \$10,000 bond.

"This investigation has the full support of the Colorado National Guard," said Maj. Gen. H. Michael Edwards, the Adjutant General of the Colorado National Guard. "If the allegations are true, this behavior is unacceptable and inconsistent with or stewardship of taxpayer resources and the trust of the citizens we serve."

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado Laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6
