**Man Charged with Vehicular Homicide in Aurora Crash that Killed Two People**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young Wednesday announced the filing of vehicular homicide charges against Joshua Lee Calhoun (DOB 08/08/86) in the March 10 three-vehicle crash that claimed the lives of Stephanie M. Windsor and Michael Lynn Ingman.

The charges allege that Calhoun's SUV crashed into the back of Windsor's Ford Escort on Tower Road at 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in Aurora in the early morning hours of March 10 and then hit a pickup truck driven by Ingman. Windsor, 44, and Ingman, 58, were both killed.

Calhoun is charged with two counts of vehicular homicide DUI (F3) and two counts of vehicular homicide reckless driving (F4).

He is free on \$50,000 bond. His advisement is set for 8:30 on April 24 in Division 4 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
