“Good Grammar Bandit” Charged in Eight Bank Robberies

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young on Thursday announced the filing of robbery charges against Levi Derek Hall (DOB 01/16/81) in the robberies of eight banks in Adams, Broomfield and Douglas counties.

The FBI’s Rocky Mountain Safe Street Task Force dubbed Hall the “Good Grammar Bandit” , saying his notes to tellers demanding money were typed with proper spelling, grammar and punctuation.

He is charged with eight counts of robbery (F4) in a string of robberies from April 2, 2014 to August 12, 2014. Institutions robbed include TCF Bank in Northglenn, three Chase Bank locations in Thornton, one Chase Bank location in Westminster, one TCF Bank in Westminster, one TCF Bank in Northglenn and one Chase Bank location in Douglas County.

Hall was arrested Monday. He posted \$5,000 bond and is due in Division 4 of Adams County Court at 2 p.m. on June 9 for a disposition hearing.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
