Ex-Director of Broomfield Nonprofit Sentenced to 10 Years Probation in Child Pornography Case

Terence J. Kiernan (DOB 6/29/49) of Broomfield was sentenced to 10 years of sex offense intensive supervised probation Thursday for sexual exploitation of a child by possessing more than 20 items of child pornography.

Broomfield District Court Judge Francis Wasserman also ordered Kiernan to perform 150 hours of community service, complete a victim empathy class and pay \$2,134.66 to Broomfield FISH to pay for costs related to the case.

Kiernan was executive director of FISH, Inc., a nonprofit organization which provides assistance with food, housing and other programs to Broomfield residents. According to the arrest affidavit, Broomfield police found multiple images of child pornography on Kiernan's work computer as well as on his personal computer and other electronic devices.

He pleaded guilty in March to one count of sexual exploitation of a child for possessing more than 20 images of child pornography, a Class 4 felony.
