Street Racer Pleads Guilty to Vehicular Homicide in Fatal Crash

David Felan (DOB 10/26/86) pleaded guilty Thursday in Adams County District Court to vehicular homicide and vehicular assault in a drag race that claimed the life of 26-year-old Rachel Neiman.

The charges allege that Felan and Chicano were street racing on Federal Boulevard and 54th Avenue in Adams County when Felan lost control of his vehicle, drove into oncoming traffic and crashed into Neiman's vehicle on Nov. 7.

Felan, of Denver, pleaded guilty to one count of vehicular homicide-DUI (F3) and one count of vehicular assault-DUI (F4).

He will be sentenced at 8:30 a.m. on September 3 in Division F of Adams County District Court.

William Anthony Chicano IV (DOB 09/05/80) also is charged in the case. His trial is set for August 10 in Adams County District Court.
