Man Charged with Assault on Parole Officers in Aurora

Michael Meeks (DOB 3-26-76) has been charged with two counts of first-degree assault on a peace officer in connection with a June 8 incident in which parole officers were attempting to check on a parolee in Aurora.

According to the charges, Meeks, who was also present at the residence at the Monte Vista apartments at 2014 Emporia Street, pulled a gun on two parole officers with the Colorado Department of Corrections and was shot.

Meeks is charged with two counts of first-degree assault on a peace officer (F3) and one count of possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6).

Meeks waived formal advisement on the charges Tuesday. A preliminary hearing is set for 2 p.m. July 7 in Division 2 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
