Broomfield Woman Charged with Attempted Murder for Stabbing Husband

Carmen Bermudez (DOB 10/10/81) has been charged with attempted first-degree murder in the stabbing of her husband, Nerio Pinales on August 11.

Pinales, 45, called 911 to report that he had been assaulted by his wife at their residence in the 5000 block of W. 126th Circle in Broomfield. Police said he had fled his home and went to a neighbor's residence where he called police. He was transported to a hospital for treatment and survived.

Bermudez was charged with attempted first-degree murder after deliberation (F2), first-degree assault with a deadly weapon causing serious bodily injury (F3), and tampering with physical evidence (F6). She also is charged with a crime of violence, a sentencing enhancer.

Bermudez was advised of the charged on August 14 and is due back in Broomfield District Court at 10 a.m. September 11 for preliminary hearing. She is held on \$100,000 bond.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
