**14-year-old Boy Pleads Guilty in Broomfield Elementary School Stabbing**

A fourteen-year-old boy pleaded guilty Friday in Broomfield County District Court to first-degree assault (F2) in the stabbing at Aspen Creek Elementary School in April.

The teen stabbed a 14-year-old girl outside the school on April 30, 2015. She was flown to Children's Hospital and survived.

The teen pleaded guilty as a juvenile to first-degree assault causing serious bodily injury with a deadly weapon on an at-risk victim (F2) and aggravated juvenile offender, a sentencing enhancer.

Under the terms of the plea agreement, as an aggravated juvenile offender, he faces a sentence of three to five years in the Division of Youth Corrections. He remains in juvenile detention pending his sentencing hearing at 9 a.m. September 30 in Division A of Broomfield County District Court.
