Matthew Britton Charged with First-degree Murder in Broomfield Shooting

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Friday that Matthew Mark Britton has been charged with first-degree murder in the death of Kobe Wiley last week in Broomfield.

Britton (DOB 05/19/82) is charged with one count of first-degree murder after deliberation (F1).

Broomfield police responded to a disturbance call on September 19 at 815 Lotus Way in Broomfield and found Wiley, 54, shot several times. Wiley was transported to Good Samaritan Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

Britton was advised of the charge Friday in Broomfield District Court. A preliminary hearing is set for 8:30 on November 20.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
