Ten Men Charged in Sex Trafficking Sting

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced today that 10 men have been charged with sex trafficking in connection with an undercover sting operation last week by U.S. Immigrations and Customs Enforcement Homeland Security Investigations.

The charges include attempted trafficking of a minor for sexual servitude (F3), solicitation of a child for prostitution (F3) and attempted sexual assault of a child (F5).

The defendants are charged as follows:

All of the charges relate to criminal conduct on January 21 and 22 of last week.

Burgos, Sauer and Smith are set to appear in Division 7 of Adams County Court today (Tuesday) at 1:30 p.m. for filing of charges. The other defendants are set for filing of charges at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday in Division 7.

As a result of media inquiries, we are releasing information about the employment of defendant Hocker and Suvanprateep. Hocker is employed as an elementary school teacher at Warren Village in Denver. Suvanprateep is an employee of Aurora Public Schools but works in a warehouse position that does not put him in contact with children.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
