**Former Commerce City Police Officer Charged with Unlawful Sexual Contact**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Monday the filing of three misdemeanor counts of unlawful sexual contact against John Reinhart, a former Commerce City Police Officer.

Reinhart was issued a summons on Friday, March 11, and is scheduled to appear in Division R of Adams County Court at 8:30 a.m. on May 5.

A female reported an incident that occurred during an arrest in September 2015 that led to an investigation and filing of charges. Reinhart is charged with three counts of unlawful sexual contact (M1) concerning three different victims.

The city placed the officer on administrative leave February 17. Reinhart resigned from the police department March 11.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
