Man Charged with Burglary and Assault on a Police Officer

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced today that multiple charges, including burglary and assault on a police officer, have been filed against Nathan James Wallace who rammed police vehicles with a stolen truck after a liquor store burglary in Thornton.

Wallace (DOB 07/20/83) is charged with first-degree assault (F3), two counts of first-degree burglary (F3), vehicular eluding (F4), criminal mischief (F4), two counts of attempted second-degree assault (F5), two counts of menacing (F5), aggravated motor vehicle theft (F5) and possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6).

Thornton police responded Sunday morning to a report of a burglary at 80000 Liquors at 2683 E. 120th Avenue. Wallace was arrested after ramming police patrol vehicles with a stolen truck during pursuit by Thornton police.

Wallace will be advised of the charges today (Wednesday) at 1:30 p.m. in Division 4 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
