Woman charged with First-degree Murder in Motel Stabbing

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that Maria Guadalupe Morado has been charged with first-degree murder (F1) and criminal impersonation (F6) in the stabbing death of a woman at an Adams County motel last Thursday.

Morado (DOB 09/23/92) is charged with stabbing 28-year-old Savanna Alli Chapman in the chest on May 19 at the White Rock Motel at 5555 Federal Boulevard. Chapman was transported to Denver Health Medical Center where she was pronounced dead. Morado is also charged with giving a false name to law enforcement officers.

Morado was advised of the charges in Adams County District Court on Wednesday. A preliminary hearing is set for 9 a.m. August 19 in Division Q of Adams County District Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
