Man Sentenced to 20 Years in Prison for Second-degree Murder

Shaun Jeff Snow was sentenced to 20 years in prison Tuesday in the shooting death of Casey Griego last July.

Snow (DOB 01/19/81) had pleaded guilty to second-degree murder in the case and faced a maximum 24-year prison sentence under the terms of the plea agreement.

Adams County deputies found Griego (DOB 02/13/73) shot on the floor of a garage at 7618 Grace Place in unincorporated Adams County on July 27, 2015. He was pronounced dead at Denver Health Medical Center.

Evidence in the case showed that Snow went to the residence for a drug deal and the two argued about a gun that Snow previously had sold to Griego, which Griego said was defective. Griego was shot as the argument escalated.
