Father Sentenced to 26 Years in Death of His 2-month-old Son

Martin Fernando Holguin, Jr., (DOB 12-11-90) was sentenced to 26 years in prison Thursday for child abuse resulting in death (F2) in connection with the death of his 2-month-old son in 2013.

“When an innocent two month old baby is killed it is heartbreaking and difficult to comprehend,” said District Attorney Dave Young. “Aiden had his whole life ahead of him and now we will never know what potential he held and what he would have become. These cases are the most sad and tragic cases that we prosecute.”

Holguin pleaded guilty as charged to child abuse resulting in death.

Aurora police officers found Aiden Martin Holguin unresponsive on September 16, 2013, when they were called to the residence at 1641 N. Hanover Street. The infant’s mother, Tailem Reyes, was working and Aiden was in his father’s care. The infant suffered severe head trauma including a skull fracture and brain hemorrhage, according to physicians at Children’s Hospital. Holguin gave several versions of how Aiden was injured to police, stating that he became stressed by his son’s crying and “head-butted” his son.
