Repeat Drunk Driver Sentenced to 8 Years in Prison

Wesley Glen Hunt of Brighton was sentenced to eight years in prison on Wednesday in Adams County District Court for felony DUI and child abuse. This was his fifth DUI offense.

Hunt (DOB 09/17/80) was on bond for his fourth DUI arrest in a Weld County case when he drove while highly intoxicated with his two young daughters, ages 5 and 7, in the car on March 28. He arrived at his girlfriend's home in Brighton after hitting several parked cars, driving on the wrong side of the road and driving over a mailbox.

One of the children said he had also hit a parked car in a parking lot and drove away so fast that she hit her face in the vehicle, giving her a black eye. She said she thought they were going to "die" because of the way "daddy" was driving.

Hunt has prior DUI or DWAI convictions in 1999, 2001, and 2005. He is set for sentencing in the Weld County case on August 30.
