Two men Charged in Adams County Murder

District Attorney Dave Young announced Tuesday that first-degree murder charges have been filed against Ronnie Williams and Corey Taylor Carroll, both of Limon, in the shooting death of Steven Kent last week in Adams County.

Kent, 55, was shot at his home at 16400 Tucson Street in unincorporated Adams County where he lived with his mother.

Williams (DOB 08/24/81) and Carroll (DOB 11/15/91) both are charged with first-degree felony murder (F1), first-degree burglary (F3), four counts of aggravated robbery (F3) and two counts of crime of violence as a sentencing enhancer.

Both men were formally advised of the charges Tuesday. They will be in court January 6 for setting of preliminary hearing at 8:30 a.m. in Division Q of Adams County District Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
