Man Charged in Drive-by Shooting at Player's Club in Adams County

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that Adrian Sandoval has been charged with seven counts of attempted first-degree murder in a drive-by shooting last weekend at the Player's Club in Adams County.

Sandoval (DOB 05/24/96) is charged with seven counts of attempted first-degree murder with extreme indifference (F2) for firing multiple shots from the passenger seat of a moving vehicle at seven individuals standing in front of and inside the bar. He also is charged with crime of violence, a sentencing enhancer.

The shooting took place at about 4:30 a.m. on Sunday, January 8 at the bar at 6710 Federal Boulevard after Sandoval and his companions had been told to leave. Sandoval (DOB 05/24/96) is charged with firing at the bar and security guards who responded and returned fire.

Sandoval appeared in Adams County Court Wednesday afternoon for formal advisement on the charges. A preliminary hearing is set for 10 a.m. on Feb. 1 in Division 6. He is held on \$500,000 bond.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
