Man Charged with First-degree Murder in Stabbing Death of Store Manager

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that Anthony Dennis Grayson has been charged with first-degree murder F1) after deliberation in the stabbing death of a man at a Family Dollar store in Adams County last Thursday.

The charges allege that Grayson (DOB 09/23/73) stabbed store manager Alejandro Alvear, 49, during an argument. The confrontation began when Grayson set off an alarm as he began to leave the store at 7067 Pecos Street after making a purchase on September 1, 2016. Alvear died of multiple stab wounds.

Grayson was advised of the charges Wednesday morning. His preliminary hearing is set for 9 a.m. on October 13 in Division F of Adams County District Court. He is held without bond.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
