Man Convicted of Conspiracy to Commit Aggravated Robbery and First Degree Burglary in Home Invasion Robbery.

Lamonte Terrance Burgette was convicted February 8, 2017 of two counts of First Degree Burglary, Class 3 Felony, and one count of Conspiracy to Commit Aggravated Robbery, Class 4 Felony, in a home invasion robbery in January 2016 in which a man was shot.

Burgette (DOB 11/8/93) of Westminster set up the robbery of a residence at 1201 E. 85TH Place in Adams County for cash and marijuana. Robert Currie, who lived at the residence, was shot after three men entered the home with masks covering their faces. Burgette had arranged to come to the residence shortly before the robbery for marijuana.

Sentencing is set for 8:30 a.m. on April 10th, 2017 in Division F.

Mario Jesus Marquez (12/27/93) was also charged in the case. Marquez plead guilty to Assault in the Second Degree in October and was sentenced to ten years in the Department of Corrections. Quinton Elijah Watts (DOB 02/08/94) was also charged in the case. Watts plead guilty to robbery (F4) in April and was sentenced to five years probation.
