Man Convicted of Second-degree Murder in 2010 Aurora Shooting

Cesar Reyes-Marquez was convicted Thursday of second-degree murder and attempted murder in a 2010 shooting in Aurora that killed one man and wounded two others.

The shooting took place during a confrontation between employees at two body shops near 3770 Wheeling Street in Aurora on July 11, 2010. Reyes-Marquez (DOB 12-12-74) began firing at some of the men. Servando Morelos-Avila (DOB 10-26-81) was killed. Gabriel Campos (DOB 1-01-79) and Hugo Perada-Lopez (DOB 10-06-86) were wounded.

An Adams County District Court jury deliberated about an hour before convicting Reyes-Marquez on one count of second-degree murder, two counts of second-degree attempted murder and two counts of first-degree assault.

Sentencing is set for 8:30 a.m. July 11 in Division F of Adams County District Court.
