**Man Charged with First-degree Murder in Death of Child in Broomfield**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Tuesday that Emanuel Joseph Doll has been charged with two counts of first-degree murder in the death of a young child last week in Broomfield.

Doll (DOB 03/02/92) appeared in Broomfield County District Court Tuesday afternoon for formal advisement of the charges. Doll is charged with one count of first-degree murder after deliberation (F1) and one count of first-degree murder of a child by a person in a position of trust (F1).

A preliminary hearing is set for 9 a.m. July 14 in Division A of Broomfield County District Court.

The affidavit remains sealed in the case. A hearing is set for 9 a.m. May 12 to consider unsealing it.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
