Arapahoe County Deputy Charged in Collision with Colorado State Trooper

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Thursday that Arapahoe County Deputy Sheriff Dale Davis has been charged with careless driving resulting in injury and failing to drive on the right side of the road in connection with an accident in which Davis collided with a Colorado State Patrol trooper's vehicle while both were responding to an emergency.

The accident took place on June 17 near East 48th Avenue and Manila Road in Aurora.

Davis, 35, was served with a summons and complaint on Thursday charging him with misdemeanor careless driving resulting in injury and failing to drive on the right side of the road, a traffic infraction.

He is due in court at 2 p.m. September 29 in Division R of Adams County Court for advisement.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
