Softball Coach Charged with Sexually Assaulting Former Team Member

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Friday that Jason Lee Davis has been charged with sexual assault on a child by a person in a position of trust (F4).

Davis (DOB 06/17/74) is accused of sexually assaulting a 15-year-old girl at the Margaret Carpenter Recreation Center on April 2. Davis previously was the coach of the victim's Broomfield Thunder softball team.

Davis was advised of the charge Friday in Adams County Court. A preliminary hearing is set for 2:30 p.m. August 25 in Division 5.

A criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
