Juvenile Charged as an Adult with Attempted Murder in RTD Bus Shooting

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Tuesday that Quomane Johnson has been charged with attempted first-degree murder in a shooting on an RTD bus that wounded a man who was riding the bus with his two young children.

The charges allege that Johnson shot Francisco Andujo, 25, on August 13 during an altercation on an RTD bus near East Colfax Avenue and North Sable Boulevard.

Johnson (DOB 05/10/01) is charged as an adult with one count of attempted first-degree murder (F2), first-degree assault (F3) and possession of a handgun by a juvenile.

Johnson was advised of the charges Tuesday in Adams County District Court. A status hearing is set for 8:30 a.m. September 19 in Division G. He is held on \$50,000 bond.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
