Adams County Man Sentenced to 24 to life for Sexual Assault on a Child

An Adams County man was sentenced Thursday to 24 years to life in prison for kidnapping and aggravated sexual assault on a child in connection with an incident in July 2016 in which he lured a 7-year-old girl to his apartment.

Moises Godoy (DOB 11/25/68) was at an apartment complex swimming pool when he lured the girl to his apartment at 1769 Coronado Parkway, asking her if she wanted to see his pet duck. The girl went to his apartment and was sexually assaulted.

Another girl at the pool said Godoy had been asking children at the pool if they needed help learning to swim and also asked several of them if they wanted to see his pet duck.

An Adams County jury convicted Godoy on charges of second-degree kidnapping (F2), aggravated sexual assault on a child (F4) and enticement of a child (F4) on August 17.

Adams County District Court Judge Thomas Ensor sentenced Godoy to 24 years for kidnapping, 16 years to life for aggravated sexual assault on a child and six years to life for enticement of a child, all to be served concurrently. The judge also ordered that he not have contact with his children.
