**Denver Deputy Sheriff Charged with Felony Menacing**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced that Bret Martin Carbone has been charged with felony menacing.

Carbone (DOB 04/20/71) is accused of pointing a gun at a process server who came to his home in the 11800 block of Granby Street in Commerce City on November 6. Carbone is a Denver deputy sheriff.

Carbone is charged with one count of felony menacing with a weapon (F5). He was advised of the charge Thursday in Adams County Court. A disposition hearing is set for 9 a.m. December 19 in Division 4 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
