Mom who Left Baby in Car during Snowstorm Pleads to Child Abuse

Nicole Carmon pleaded guilty Friday to negligent child abuse causing serious bodily injury and attempted first degree assault for leaving her 2-year-old son in a car overnight during a snowstorm last December.

Carmon (DOB 12/29/89) faces a prison sentence of five to ten years under the terms of the plea agreement. Both charges are class 4 felonies.

She will be sentenced at 8:30 a.m. December 4 in Division F of Adams County District Court.

Thornton police found Carmon's son strapped to a car seat in her vehicle in a parking lot at 901 E. 120th Avenue on December 17. Multiple Thornton police officers were dispatched to search for the vehicle after Carmon reported that she had left her son in her vehicle overnight during the snow storm but did not know where. The boy was rushed to the hospital for treatment of frostbite and hypothermia.
