Man Charged with Attempted First-Degree Murder for Firing Shots in Aurora Apartment

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that James Cathcart-Curtiss has been charged with attempted first-degree murder extreme indifference and illegal discharge of a firearm in a shooting Sunday in an Aurora apartment complex.

Cathcart-Curtiss (DOB 09/11/85) is charged with three counts of attempted first-degree murder extreme indifference (F2) and one count of illegal discharge of a firearm (F5) for firing his weapon through walls inside his apartment at 5714 N. Gibraltar Way in Aurora.

He was advised of the charges Wednesday in Adams County Court. A preliminary hearing is set for 2:30 p.m. March 13 In Division 4 of Adams County Court. He is held on \$50,000 bond.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
