Judge Finds Emanuel Doll Incompetent to Stand Trial in Child's Murder

Broomfield County District Judge Michael Goodbee has ruled that Emanuel Doll is incompetent to stand trial for first-degree murder in the death of his 4-year-old nephew.

The judge ordered that Doll be committed to the Colorado Mental Health Institute in Pueblo. The criminal case is stayed until he is restored to competency. The written ruling was issued Sunday after a hearing on competency last month. A review hearing is set for 9 a.m. March 19.

Doll (DOB 03/02/92) is charged with one count of first-degree murder after deliberation (F1) and one count of first-degree murder of a child by a person in a position of trust (F1).

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. See Colo. RPC 3.6.
