Woman Charged with Vehicular Homicide in Wrong Way Crash that Killed Two

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that Kimberly Rodriguez Roldan has been charged with vehicular homicide while driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol in a head-on crash that killed two people when she drove the wrong way on I-25.

Roldan (DOB 10/08/93) is charged with driving her Jeep Grand Cherokee southbound in a northbound I-25 HOV lane near 58th Avenue on January 27 when she hit a Honda CRV head-on. Miguel Ramirez-Gutierrez, 47, and his 17-year-old son, Michael Ramirez-Muro, were killed. Two other passengers in that vehicle, Maria Muro-Palacios, 45, and Salma Ramires-Muro, 20, suffered serious injuries and were rushed to the hospital by ambulance.

Roldan is charged with two counts of vehicular homicide while under the influence of drugs or alcohol (F3) and two counts of vehicular assault while DUI (F4).

Roldan will be in court for formal advisement of charges at 8:30 a.m. on April 6 in Division 2 of Adams County Court. She is free on \$20,000 bond with supervised release and monitored sobriety.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
