Brighton Middle School Teacher Charged with Sexual Assault on a Child

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Wednesday that Rory Seeman, a teacher at Overland Trail Middle School in Brighton, has been charged with four counts of sexual assault on a child involving two students at the school.

Seeman (DOB 09/29/84) is charged with two counts of sexual assault on a child by a person in a position of trust (F3), and two counts of sexual assault on a child (F4).

Seeman teaches computer skills at Overland Trail Middle School at 455 N. 19th Avenue. The charges relate to his conduct between August and November of last year with two 7th grade girls, then ages 11 and 12, who were in his class.

Seeman was advised of the charge Wednesday in Adams County Court. A preliminary hearing will be set at 8:30 a.m. June 1 in Division 3.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado law. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
