Man Extradited to Face Charges in 2015 Broomfield Murder

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Tuesday that Ricardo Enrique Munoz-Diaz has been extradited from Mexico to Broomfield County to face trial on charges of first-degree murder of a woman who was stabbed to death in 2015.

Amalia Karolina Lopez-Leon, 33, was found dead in her mobile home at 2885 E. Midway Boulevard on October 18, 2015.

Munoz-Diaz (DOB 02/02/88) is charged with first-degree murder after deliberation, first-degree felony murder, two counts of aggravated robbery, two counts of second-degree burglary, violation of the Pawnbroker's Act, and two counts of crime of violence, which are sentencing enhancers

Munoz-Diaz appeared in Broomfield District Court Monday afternoon for formal advisement. A preliminary hearing is set for 1:30 p.m. on September 20 in Division A.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
