**Man Charged with Felony Criminal Mischief in Car Window Shooting Spree**

17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Thursday that Tomas Medina-Martinez has been charged with felony criminal mischief and contributing to the delinquency of a minor for shooting out the windows of more than 100 vehicles in Commerce City last weekend.

Most of the vehicles were damaged in south Commerce City early Saturday morning.

Medina (DOB 03/09/98) is charged with criminal mischief (F4) and contributing to the delinquency of a minor (F4).

He was advised of the charges Thursday in Adams County Court. His next court appearance is 9 a.m. March 5 in Division R2 of Adams County Court.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado law. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
