Woman Charged with Attempted Murder in Broomfield Walmart Shooting

17th Judicial District Attorney Dave Young announced Friday that Alyssa Borquez has been charged with seven counts of attempted first-degree murder in a shooting at a Walmart store in Broomfield on Tuesday.

Borquez (DOB 05/16/98) was arrested at the Walmart at 4651 W. 121st Avenue in Broomfield Tuesday afternoon.

She is charged with one count of attempted first-degree murder after deliberation (F2) and six counts of attempted first-degree murder with extreme indifference (F2).

Borquez was advised of the charges Friday in Broomfield County Court. A preliminary hearing is set for 1:30 p.m. March 19 in Division 1. Bond is set at \$50,000.

The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual committed a crime under Colorado law. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
