**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF WARRANTLESS ARREST**

Lauren Schuster, a peace officer for the City and County of Broomfield, being duly sworn says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named defendant for the charge(s) stated above, arising out of incidents occurring at [REDACTED] 167th W ave, City and County of Broomfield, State of Colorado, on 02/27/2026 , and that the following facts are true and correct to the best of her knowledge, information and belief, and support the arrest of the defendant:

On Friday February 27th 2026 I responded to [REDACTED] W 167th ave on the report of a disturbance that occurred between the reporting party, [REDACTED] and her boyfriend Randon Fontenette (07/05/2005).

Dispatch informed me that [REDACTED] stated she was physically assaulted and had bruises and her phone was broken. Ransom was not on scene at this time but [REDACTED] would be at [REDACTED] as she did not want to be in the apartment.

Upon arrival I contacted [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] she offered to take officers to the address where the incident occurred as there was a hole in the wall that was made by her phone.

The following portion of this report will be written chronologically not the order that it was learned.

[REDACTED] stated that she came home from work and let the two dogs out then laid on the couch. Ransom then arrived home and discovered dog poop on the stairs and was angry at [REDACTED] for not knowing about it and cleaning it up. Ransom told [REDACTED] to go clean it up and then went upstairs to shower.

After showering Ransom came down stairs where [REDACTED] was on the couch. Ransom was leaving and wanted a kiss from [REDACTED] before doing so as she told him that she did not want to go. Ransom then started grabbing her and trying to pull her into giving her a kiss. [REDACTED] pushed him away from her and then went upstairs to disengage the situation.

Ransom followed her upstairs where [REDACTED] was now on the bed. Ransom continued to try and grab her and force her to give him a kiss. Ransom is laying on top of her and grabbing her arms and legs. Ransom then grabs her neck with one hand, [REDACTED] was unsure which hand, and applies pressure. Using a scale of 0-10 0 being no pressure and 10 being the most amount of pressure [REDACTED] stated that it was about a 4. [REDACTED] believed that the strangulation occurred for 10-30 seconds.

[REDACTED] stated that she was able to talk and while it felt difficult to breathe she was able to breathe. [REDACTED] did not know for certain what made Ransom stop but stated that she thinks he got annoyed with her and rolled off of her. [REDACTED] stated that Ransom looked angry during the incident and was stating "give me a kiss so I leave" and she kept saying "get off".

██████████ then attempted to separate from Randon again and went down stairs to the couch again. Randon followed her down stairs and sat next to her on the couch and again tried to force her to give him a kiss. He continually was grabbing her arms and ██████████ told him to get off of her.

Randon then grabbed her by the neck again and pulled ██████████ on top of him. ██████████ was unable to provide a number of pressure but stated that it was less than the previous strangulation, however, this episode lasted longer than the previous more around 30 to 60 seconds.

██████████ was unsure how this ended as she had a blank spot during this altercation and woke up on the floor looking up at Randon. This type "blank" is consistent with strangulation when the victim passes out. ██████████ did not believe she passed out.

It was at this time that Randon grabbed her phone and threw it at the wall. This caused a hole in the wall and damaged her phone screen and camera.

██████████ attempted to leave at this point and Randon followed her down the stairs requesting she give him her phone and stating that if she left he would not let her back in. ██████████ stated that Randon stood in front of the door that made it more difficult for her to leave as she had to slip around him. ██████████ stated she did not feel she could not leave as she was eventually able to leave.

██████████ did not have any shoes on at this point and yelled at him to leave and Randon then left and ██████████ went to her friend's house.

██████████ stated that she was not in any pain during the assault nor was she in any pain now even with the bruises staging she bruises easily. I asked about the amount of pressure he had when grabbing her using the same scale as explained with the strangulation and she stated that it was about a 9.

While interviewing ██████████ multiple fingerprint shaped bruises were visible on both of her arms. During the initial interview no bruises were observed on her neck.

At this time we moved back to the friend's house and filled out the ODARA form, the Starnugulation form. ██████████ was tracking randon and had observed he was coming back to the city and did not want to see him again. ██████████ did not want to complete an FNE at this time. Going over symptoms she stated at the time of strangulation she had a red face but did not feel any pain at the moment, nor did she now. ██████████ also stated she did not have any difficulty swallowing. No Petichie was observed.

██████████ informed officers that Randon was now back at the address. And after completing all necessary forms Officer updegraff and I attempted to make contact with Randon. He refused to come to the door.

I observed that his vehicle was in the garage and that the dogs previously kenneled in the garage were heard in the residence. Myself and Officer Updegraff made commands and Randon still did not come to the door. At this point more officers were called. Officer Updegraff and Bah stayed at the residence to continue making announcements requesting contact while Sergeant Martinez and I spoke with [REDACTED] again.

While speaking with [REDACTED] observed a bruise that was not there when speaking to her earlier, this was photographed. [REDACTED] eventually consented to a FNE and left the area with an officer to Denver Health for an FNE.

Due to Randon being known to possess a firearm and no response to approximately an hour of commands to open the door, multiple attempts to call Randon SWAT and CNT responded.

While waiting for SWAT and CNT to respond to the scene dispatch informed me that through a string of text messages a friend alerted [REDACTED] that Randon knew the police were outside and he would not come down.

SWAT and CNT responded and were able to make contact with Randon who came to the door and cooperated with commands and was placed into custody.

Randon was transported to the Broomfield Police Department for an interview.

I provided Randon his Miranda advisement and he consented to speaking with myself and Detective Hiatt. Randon stated that he and [REDACTED] got in an argument over the dog poop and him talking about going to a party on instagram. As a result of her being mad he tried to be physically affectionate with her and she pushed him off which he stated he kept grabbing her as a result. [REDACTED] then went upstairs, Randon stated he kept trying to love on her and then she went downstairs where he again kept trying to grab and kiss her. She then bit him and scratched/pinched his throat which caused him to throw her off of him. Randon stated [REDACTED] charged him and he restrained her and at some point threw the phone. Randon denied ever strangling her and stated the bruises were from him restraining her from hitting him.

Randon had a visible bite mark to his arm and a scratch mark on his neck. The injuries I observed were consistent with the statement given by [REDACTED] as she stated in an effort to get him off of me I bit him and at one point pushed on his throat to get him to stop.

Randon's statement was consistent with [REDACTED] statement but the physical evidence supported [REDACTED] statement of her being strangled. As a result Randon was transported to the Broomfield Detention Center where he was booked and lodged on the above charges.
